MOTOR VEHICLES (DUPLICATE INSURANCE CERTIFICATE) ACT, 1979¹

AN ACT to provide for the issue of duplicate motor insurance certificates and for related matters.

1. Issue and misuse of duplicate motor insurance certificates

A person commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding twenty-five penalty units if that person

- (a) obtains a duplicate certificate of insurance in respect of a motor vehicle without the permission of the Ministry responsible for Fuel, or
- (b) uses or attempts to use a duplicate certificate of insurance issued in respect of a motor vehicle for the purpose of procuring anything more than the prescribed quantity of petrol to which that person is otherwise entitled in respect of that vehicle in accordance with the restrictions imposed on the sale of petrol by the Ministry responsible for Fuel and Power.

2. Validation of penalties already collected

The money collected by the Government before the coming into force of this Act, from a person who has done an act as is referred to in section 1, shall be deemed to be a penalty imposed under that section in respect of that act and lawfully collected.

This Act was issued as the Motor Vehicles (Duplicate Insurance Certificate) Decree, 1979 (A.F.R.C.D. 35), made on the 15th day of September, 1979, and notified in the Gazette on 21st September, 1979.
