## REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON FINANCE ON THE REQUEST FOR TAX AND DUTY EXEMPTIONS FOR THE SPECIFIED ITEMS UNDER THE ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECTS -KUMASI-YEJI (GYATO ZONGO -YEJI ROAD) PHASE 4

## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

The request for tax and duty exemptions for specified items as contained in the Contract Agreement for the execution of the Kumasi-Yeji (GyatoZongo-Yeji) road rehabilitation project was laid in Parliament in accordance with Article 174 of the Constitution on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> February, 1999 and referred to the Finance Committee for consideration and report.

The Committee met with the Deputy Minister of Roads and Transport Hon.

Steve Akorli and his technical staff and reports as follows:

## 2.0 BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The above-named project is being executed by INTERBETON BV of Netherlands. It would be recalled that Parliament on 14<sup>th</sup> July, 1998 approved by a resolution a Loan Agreement of NLG 18.0 million from the ABN-AMRO Bank M.V of Netherlands to co-finance the above project in accordance with Article 181 of the Constitution and Section 7 of the Loan Act 1970 (Act 335).

According to clause 9.1 of the Loan Agreement, "all payments to be made by the Borrower under the Loan Agreement shall be made without any deduction or withholding whatsoever, it being the understanding of the parties hereto that no taxes, duties, fees or other charges whatsoever as applicable to the said payments".

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Under the same clause, the Borrower, which is the Government of Ghana has expressly warranted that "no income tax or corporation tax levied or imposed by or in Ghana is applicable to payments" under the Loan Agreement.

In effect under the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement the construction contract exempts the project from:

- (a) Taxing the contractors and sub-contractors' profits
- (b) Income tax of expatriate staff
- (c) Taxes and duties on materials, equipment, plant and vehicles including spare parts, lubricants and fuel.

These exemptions find expression in clause 34 (23) and 59.9 of the Loan Agreement.

## 3.0 ESTIMATED TAX AND DUTIES TO BE PAID

The Committee was informed that tax, duties and other levies to be paid is estimated to total \$\psi 12,352,610,949.00.

## 4.0 LIST OF ITEMS TO BENEFIT FROM THE EXEMPTIONS

The itemised list of equipment, materials, fuel, lubricants and spare parts etc. and the quantum to be exempted are attached in Annexes I, II, III, IV,V.

## 5.0 OBSERVATIONS

The Committee observed that if the exemptions are not granted and the contractor and sub-contractors as well as expatriate staff are made to pay the various taxes and other fiscal levies, the taxes paid would have to be reimbursed under the works contract. This finds expression in clause 9.1 (iii) of the Loan Agreement which clearly stated that the Borrower shall "indemnify the bank against

any such payment or liability together with any interest, penalties and expenses payable or incurred in connection therewith."

It was also noted that if payment of the re-imbursement is delayed, interest would accrue. For delay payment, the contractor has the right to request for extension of time as stipulated in the works contract, the waivers if not granted would result in additional cost to the Government thereby putting a further strain on Government's expenditure.

## 6.0 RECOMMENDATION

The Committee wishes to recommend that for a speedy execution of the project and to avoid any increases in the cost of the works, the House approves the exemptions from tax and other fiscal levies prescribed in the Loan Agreement and the Contract Document in respect of materials, equipment and plant for the performance of the contract and also the contractor and sub-contractor's earning and that of their expatriate staff in accordance with Article 174 of the Constitution for the rehabilitation of Phase 4 of the (Gyato Zongo-Yeji) Road.
